Sanctions rides of 40 km/25 miles as Endurance Trials under HCBC umbrella

Pacific Northwest Endurance Rides (<https://www.pner.net/>)

Represents all of the US States and British Columbia—the Pacific Northwest Region

Coordinates ride schedule, offers many awards, yearly Endurance Conference with vendors and speakers, newsletter, handbook

Provides a number of services to British Columbia riders and ride managers, in many cases whether they are PNER members or not.

Recognizes points from all sanctioning organizations in the Pacific Northwest

National Federation for all Equestrian Sports in Canada

Sanctioning body for competitions of 80 km/50 miles and up; Sport License required if ride is EC sanctioned.

National Yearend awards and performance database

Sanctioning organization for most American Endurance Rides

Full yearly AERC membership or temporary (day) membership required if ride is AERC sanctioned.
